Entrance Hall/Lobby/ Kitchen/Toilets	Possible 'pinch points' and busy areas where there is a risk that social distancing will not be observed Door handles and light switches in frequent use	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signage to be installed to guide on social distancing and maximum occupancy (Max 2 in kitchen area) • Signs to remind about wearing of masks where social distancing of 2m cannot be observed • Updated Terms and Conditions require users to clean all surfaces (including switches and handles) that may have been contaminated at the end of their hire

Toilets	Social distancing is more difficult and higher risk of contamination from use of facilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signs up to remind users about social distancing • Users required to clean all surfaces and equipment used, at the end of the hire • Soap, paper towels and cleaning products supplied for users 	The hall will also be cleaned by the caretaker after each use
Store area	Social distancing is more difficult and higher risk of contamination from use of facilities Cleaning of foldaway tables	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Signs up to remind users about social distancing • Users required to clean all surfaces and equipment used, at the end of the hire • Users required to clean foldaway tables before and after use 	Users are required to clean foldaway tables both <u>before</u> and after use as they will not be cleaned by the caretaker between users
